Category #1 - Legal	<ul style="list-style-type: none">-not a legal issue talking about morality what best for the general public-Approximately 1.03% of the nation's adult population, or 2.6 million Americans, identify as transgender, Source<ul style="list-style-type: none">-so why spend so much time, effort and cost for only 1.03% of the population-For one bathroom to be switched over to gender bathrooms to all gender bathrooms it would cost around between \$5,000 and \$35,000. Per bathroom.Source

Category #1 - Legal	<p>“... as transgender people have been using public bathrooms and locker rooms for decades. Policies that allow transgender people to use the correct bathroom—the bathroom that best matches the transgender person's identity—do not legalize harassment, stalking, violence, or sexual assault.</p>

	Those behaviors are, and will continue to be, against the law for anyone, anywhere.” source
Category #2 - Public Safety	<p>“We all care about safety in restrooms, which is why it’s important to know that more than 400 cities across 45 states have successfully implemented policies allowing transgender people to use the restroom that matches the gender they live every day – and 21 states have enacted those laws statewide. And there’s been no increase in public safety incidents in restrooms in any of those cities or states—which makes this new law unnecessary.”</p> <p>source</p>
Category #3 - Alt. Solution	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> -Family Restrooms -One big bathroom with walls and doors and not stalls -Create more single-user, gender-neutral bathrooms available to anyone. This provides a private option without excluding by gender. -Increase privacy enhancements in all bathrooms, like full doors and partitions between urinals. This helps address safety concerns. <p>source</p>
